The instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondents to make necessary correction in the revenue record of Government with regard to residential house of petitioner comprised in Khasra No.478/128 total measuring 11 biswa which was in released category, however, it has now been shown in acquired category and that too after a lapse of more than 12 years.

Learned counsel submits that representations (Annexures P-11, P-13 and P-14) dated 31.10.2022 and 09.05.2023 respectively were also made to respondents No.4 and 5, however, they had proved to be in vain. He submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if the above representations are looked into by respondents No.4 & 5 and decided in accordance with law at the earliest.

Notice of motion.

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At the asking of Court, Mr. Chetan Sharma, AAG, Haryana, who is present in the Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, respondents No.4 & 5 are directed to look into the representations (Annexures P-11, P-13 and P-14) and decide them expeditiously, preferably within 01 month by passing a speaking order, in accordance with the provisions of law. The petitioner may not be dispossessed from the property in dispute till a decision is taken on the aforesaid representations by the authorities concerned.

The petition stands disposed of.
