The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.027 dated 23.03.2023 registered under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 at Police Station Sadar Batala, District Gurdaspur, Punjab.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 05.06.2023, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 05.06.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
