JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioners through instant petition under Article 226 of Constitution of India are seeking direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect their lives and liberty from the hands of respondents No. 5 and 6 and direct the respondent No.3 and 4 not to harass the petitioners unnecessarily.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners inter alia contends that petitioners are senior citizens. Both are more than 70 years old and they are not even able to walk properly. The private respondents in connivance with police official are harassing the petitioners. They want to grab the property of the petitioners. The petitioners have made representation dated 09.03.2023 followed by representation dated 26.05.2023 to Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to look into the grievance of the petitioners.

3. Notice of motion.
4. Learned State counsel, who on advance notice is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the official respondent and submits that State being duty bound would look into representation of the petitioners and do the needful. He assures the Court that no police officials would interfere in the life and liberty of the petitioners and if something wrong on the part of the police official is found strict action shall be taken against them.
5. In view of Statement of learned State counsel no further order is warranted. This Court in view of the statement of learned State counsel is sanguine of the fact that jurisdictional police authorities being duty bound would protect life and liberty of the petitioners and no harassment would be caused to petitioners.
6. Disposed of.
