1. This order shall dispose of above-mentioned writ petition bearing No.CWP-1165-2016 and 14 connected petitions as the question of law and facts involved in this group of cases is common. The facts are culled from CWP No.1165-2016 for convenience.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are

working with the respondent-department and at the fag end of their career, they are only praying for regularization of their services on the posts against which they are working through out their service career.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though, as of now there is no regularization policy and keeping in view the fact that the regularization policy issued in the year 2014 has been quashed by this Court in CWP No.17206-2014 titled as ***Yogesh Tyagi and another Vs. State of Haryana and others, decided on 31.05.2018***, but the said issue is still pending consideration before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

4. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that there is no stay on the judgment of this Court in ***Yogesh Tyagi's case*** (supra) and only the status-quo has been ordered by the Hon'ble Supreme Court qua the persons who have already been granted benefits under the 2014 policy before the same was quashed by this Court.

5. Faced with such a situation, learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the present petitions may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to approach the respondents-department for the relief being claimed by the petitioners in the present petitions to be considered sympathetically or to grant for permission to the petitioners to revive the present petitions in case, any right accrues to them after the decision of the appeal which is pending before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in respect of the judgment of the Court ***Yogesh Tyagi's case (supra)***.

6. Ordered accordingly.
