The instant petition has been filed for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.35, dated 19.01.2023, under Section 379-B, 392,397, 34 of IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act (later on added Section 341 of IPC), registered at Police Station Sampla,Rohtak.

As per the complainant, on 19.01.2023 he had come to his friend Deepak son of Satish to take his own clothes. At about 06:10 PM, he called his friend Deepak and Tarun and all the three were talking to each other. In the meantime, two young boys came on a motorcycle and snatched the car from them by showing them a pistol. The complainant informed the police and the FIR in the present case was registered against unknown persons. During the course of investigation, it was found that the petitioner and one more accused Honey (Juvenile) were involved in the present crime.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that he was

arrested in the present case on 19.01.2023 and is in custody for the last more than five months. The car and the pistol have already been recovered from him. The investigation is complete in all respect and the challan has been presented before the competent Court of law. He further contends that the trial of the case is likely to take long time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining him in custody.

On the other hand, learned State counsel has vehemently opposed the concession of regular bail to the petitioner on the ground that he is involved in a serious crime and one more case under Arms Act has already been registered against him. However, he does not dispute the fact that the petitioner is in custody in the said case.

Taking into consideration the totality of the facts and circumstances and without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail pending trial on his furnishing bail bonds and surety to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/ Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate.
