The present application has been filed under Section 151 CPC for disposal of the main writ petition.

Vide order dated 03.05.2016, the present case was admitted.

On the oral request of learned counsel for the parties, the main case is taken on today's board.

Main case

This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the order dated 22.06.2015 (Annexure P-8) passed by respondent No.4, whereby petitioner has been repatriated from BBMB to PSPCL. Further,

a prayer for mandamus has been made for directing the respondents not to transfer and repatriate the petitioner from the BBMB to PSPCL.

Learned counsel for the applicant-respondent Nos.3 and 4 submits that grievance of the petitioner stands redressed, and even the petitioner stands superannuated from the service on 30.04.2022, therefore, nothing survives for adjudication in the present writ petition.

The above fact is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the statements made by learned counsel for the parties as well as contents of the application, present writ petition is rendered infructuous.
