The present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. has been filed for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.91 dated 02.10.2021, under Section 22(c) of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (offence under Section 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, added later on), registered at Police Station Bajakhana, District Faridkot.
