Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, '*the Cr.P.C.*') for directing respondent Nos.1 to 3 to provide adequate protection to the life and liberty of petitioners at the hands of respondent Nos.4 & 5.

2. Status report filed by way of affidavit of Mr. Prithvi Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Dirba, dated 14.06.2023, is taken on record. Copy thereof be supplied to the opposite side during the course of the day.

Registry to tag the same at appropriate place.

3. For reference, relevant portion of para No.4 of the aforesaid affidavit is extracted as under:-

“4. But both the petitioners are not found to be in danger of life and liberty from anyone. Moreover, if the petitioners will come in the jurisdiction of Police Station, Dirba and approach the local Police for providing

protection, same will be provided to them as per the procedure.”

4. It view of the above extract, it is clearly discernible that as on today, there is no threat to the life and liberty of petitioners; therefore, no further directions are required to be issued in the matter.
5. Consequently, present petition is disposed off.
6. Needless to say that in case an occasion so arises, the petitioners would be at liberty to take recourse to the remedy, as per law.
