RAVI SHANKER JHA, CHIEF JUSTICE (ORAL)

1. Learned Additional Solicitor General of India appearing on behalf of National Disaster Management Authority/respondents No.1 and 2 as well as learned State counsel, submit that the authorities are following and would follow the decision of the Supreme Court rendered in case titled as “**Measures for Prevention of Fatal Accidents of Small Children Due to their falling into Abandoned BoreWells and Tubewells: in RE Vs. Union of India and others**”, (2010) 15 Supreme Court Cases 223.

2. As the Supreme Court has already laid down guidelines in the aforesaid decision and the statement is being made before this Court
