The petitioner alleges violation of the order dated 15.02.2019 passed by this Court in CWP-4124-2019, vide which the directions were issued to maintain status quo regarding possession as well as subsequent order dated 03.04.2019, vide which the writ petition was disposed of with a direction to Commissioner, Jalandhar Division, Jalandhar to decide the application for stay referred to by the petitioner on or before 30.04.2019 or a subsequent date.

Since a period of more than two and a half year has passed when the directions were issued, it is apparent that the application for stay stands decided.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous.

Rule stands discharged.

The petitioner is granted liberty to avail his alternative remedy in accordance with law, if so required.
