1. The petitioner had filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus for releasing the detainee, namely, Kanchan Rani, aged about 26 years from the alleged illegal detention of the private respondents.
2. In compliance of the order dated 02.06.2023, respondent No.3 has produced the alleged detainee, namely, Kanchan Rani, before this Court today. I have interacted with the alleged detainee. She has submitted that she is aged about 26 years and is a graduate. At present she is staying with her parents, i.e. respondents No.4 and 5 voluntarily. However, she wants to go with her husband, i.e. Angrej Singh, the present petitioner.
3. In view of the statement made by the alleged detainee, nothing survives in the present petition. Since she is major, she is at liberty to go to a place of her choice.
4. The present petition is disposed of, accordingly.
