1. On 12.09.2023, the following order was passed:-

“Arguments have been heard at some length.

The dispute is with regard to the payment of maintenance. As per the impugned order, the petitioner (wife) is earning Rs.57,000/- per month, whereas, the husband is earning Rs.55,000/- per month.

The learned counsel representing the petitioner contends that elder daughter of the parties is now studying in Chitkara University and the petitioner is paying annual fee of Rs.1,55,000/-. He submits that the respondent is paying tuition fee at the rate of Rs.13,000/- per quarter for the younger son.

The learned counsel representing the respondent prays for a short accommodation to take instructions from the respondent for making contribution towards tuition fee of his daughter.

2. Learned counsel representing the respondent (husband) submits that the respondent is paying the tuition fee of his son at the rate of Rs.17,000/- per quarter whereas he is paying Rs.26,000/- towards the rent of the premises, which the petitioner occupies. He further submits that as per the order of the court, he is further paying Rs.2,000/- as maintenance pendente lite.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, there is no further scope for enhancement.

4. Hence, dismissed.

5. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
