On 18.01.2023, following order was passed:-

“Parties have agreed to settle the dispute on making payment of Rs.1,60,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by learned MACT. Counsel for the claimant has signed the proposal sheet.

To us, this offer seems to be just, reasonable and equitable in the facts and circumstances of the case. Learned counsel for the respondent-Insurance Company prays for time to get concurrence from the concerned authority.

To come up on 23.01.2023.

Copy of the order be supplied to the representative/counsel of the respondent-Insurance Company. ”

Mr. Namit Khurana, Advocate for the appellant was present. He signed the consent agreement, showing willingness to accept an amount of Rs.1,60,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Sixty Thousand Only) towards full and final settlement of the claim in the present appeal.

Mr. Sanjeev Goyal, Advocate for the respondent No.2-Insurance Company has also signed the said statement today accepting the proposal made by counsel for the appellant.

As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellant, the enhanced

amount will be paid to the appellant-Dushyant (minor) through his mother Ms.

Rajan Rani.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit the enhanced amount of Rs.1,60,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Sixty Thousand only) by cheque/draft, in favour of appellant-Dushyant (minor) through his mother Ms. Rajan Rani with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 10.03.2023. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellant's counsel may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat after retaining the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
