1. Review of the judgment passed on 13.02.2023 has been sought by filing the present review application. The petitioners complain that while deciding a batch of cases, this Court has not examined a particular issue.

2. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the learned counsel representing the petitioners has been heard. She submits that the petitioner herein is an inservice candidate and the experience earned by her while working as JBT Teacher before passing the qualifying examination, should be taken into consideration.

3. This Court has considered the submissions made by the learned counsel representing the petitioners. For appointment to the post of Head Teacher, the required educational qualification in the recruitment notice reads as under:-

“(i) Should possess Bachelor’s Degree from a recognized university or institution with atleast 50% marks as per guidelines of the University Grants Commission.

(ii) Should possess two years Elementary Teachers Training course from a recognized university or institution or two years Diploma in Elementary Education (D.El.Ed.) as per guidelines of the National Council for Teachers Education or Bachelor Degree in Education (B.Ed) from a recognized university or institution as per guidelines of the University Grants Commission and

(iii) Should possess teaching experience of working as Primary School Teacher for a minimum period of three years in a Central/State Government School. However, a prospective candidate must have acquired such experience after acquiring the minimum educational and professional qualifications specified for the posts under these Rules.”

5. It is evident that as per the clause (iii), the experience acquired after passing the minimum educational/ professional qualification is required to be taken into consideration. The applicant herein, passed the Bachelor degree in the year 2018 whereas the recruitment notice was issued in the year 2019. Hence, she does not fulfill the requirement of teaching experience, which requires experience of working as primary teacher for a period of 3 years.

6. In view of the aforesaid, no ground to review the order dated 13.02.2023 is made out.

7. Dismissed.
