1. Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing impugned order dated 03.06.2019 (Annexure P-8) passed by respondent No.2, whereby, promotion order dated 01.02.2019 (Annexure P-7) has been withdrawn. Petitioner has also sought quashing of order dated 03.06.2019 (Annexure P-9) whereby, benefit of second ACP has been withdrawn.

2. In its response filed by way of affidavit of Shri Ajit Balaji Joshi, Director General, Agriculture and Farmers Welfare Department, Haryana, Panchkula, it has been submitted as under:-

“10. That the office of deponent vide order dated 10.06.2019 (Annexure P-8) and vide order dated 10.06.2019 (Annexure P-9) withdrew the promotion order and the benefit of 2nd ACP scale to the petitioner. It is submitted that now the deponent vide orders dated 24.07.2019 (sic has) withdrawn the above orders dated 10.06.2019 (Annexure P-8) and 10.06.2019 (Annexure P-9) and restored the benefit of promotion and 2nd ACP scale to the petitioner. The copies of the same are annexed as Annexures R-1 and R-2 for the kind perusal of this Hon’ble Court. It is further submitted that the case of the petitioner for granting the benefit of 2nd ACP scale and promotion order to the post of Accountant would be considered as per rules/Government instructions and accordingly afresh order can be passed. This Hon’ble Court vide order dated 22.07.2019 imposed the cost of Rs.10,000/- and office of deponent deposited the same amount in the Bar Association of this Hon’ble Court on 25.07.2019 vide receipt No.5740.”

3. In view of above stand taken by respondent No.2, writ petition has become infructuous and is dismissed as such.
