Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.198 dated 24.1.2020 registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC and Section 3 of Haryana Protection of Interest of Depositors in Financial Establishment Act at Police Station Shivaji Nagar, District Gurgaon.

Counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the petitioner was not involved in the alleged transactions as are detailed in the FIR and her husband Ajay Raghav is still in custody and further, the petitioner is suffering from renal problem and is undergoing dialysis twice a week. He further submits that the petitioner joined the investigation with the police in compliance of previous order of interim bail.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Sunil apprised the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police and has not

disputed the fact that the petitioner is on regular dialysis as she is suffering

from serious kidney problem. State counsel further submits that the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation and her husband already stands arrested by the police.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 27.7.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
