The present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is filed seeking quashing of FIR No.122 dated 08.06.2018 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 120-B and 420 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 24 of the Immigration Act, registered at Police Station City Kharar, District S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali) and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise/affidavit dated 08.09.2020 of respondent No.2/complainant.

A perusal of file reveals that no one is appearing to represent the petitioner since last three dates, i.e. 21.12.2022, 13.01.2023 and 24.02.2023.

As per office report, information letter sent to the petitioner in terms of last order dated 24.02.2023 has not been received back served or
