MEENAKSHI I. MEHTA, J.(Oral)

The petitioner herein has sought the relief of pre-arrest/anticipatory bail in the criminal case arisen out of the FIR bearing No.51 dated 20.05.2022 registered at Police Station Doraha, District Khanna, under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC.

2. Today, learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Lakhwinder Singh from the afore-referred Police Station, informs the Court that in compliance of the order dated 21.07.2022 passed by the Co-ordinate Bench, the petitioner has joined in the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required and he is also not involved in any other criminal case.

3. As per the report of the Mediator at Flag 'C', the parties have amicably settled their dispute. Learned counsels for the petitioner and respondent No.2 admit the above-said fact. Learned counsel for respondent No.2 also acknowledges the compliance of the terms and conditions of the afore-said settlement by the petitioner till date.

4. In view of the above-discussed facts and circumstances, the present petition is allowed and the relief of interim bail, as extended to the petitioner named Gurjinder Singh by the Co-ordinate Bench vide the said order dated 21.07.2022, is hereby made absolute.

5. However, the petitioner shall continue to join in the investigation as and when required/called upon to do so and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
