1. As per the directions issued by the Court earlier on 17.01.2020, the High Powered Committee examined the case of the petitioner under the Chairmanship of the Chief Secretary, Punjab and the petitioner has already been held entitled to the financial benefits from 20.03.2014, and vide order dated 08.02.2022, the petitioner-Kulpreet Singh has been ordered to be placed in the seniority list as PCS (Executive Branch) at Sr.No.364-A after Major Dr. Amit, PCS (Sr.No.364) and before Smt. Jyoti Bala, PCS (Sr. No.365). The said order dated 08.02.2022 has been placed along with reply by the respondents.

2. This Court is of the opinion that the petitioner has been granted appropriate relief. However, learned counsel for the petitioner has insisted that the petitioner ought to be given notional benefits from 2012. This Court finds that the order passed on 08.02.2022 is not challenged by the petitioner.

3. Having noticed the order passed by the Government of Punjab appointing petitioner-Kulpreet Singh in the PCS (Executive Branch) and giving him the appropriate seniority with his batch mates according to his merit, no further relief can be granted to him.

4. The Writ Petition has become infructuous and the same is **dismissed** as such.

5. All the pending applications shall stand disposed of accordingly.
