1. This is an application filed under Section 151 read with Article 226 of the Constitution of India for withdrawal of the main writ petition.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant/petitioner has submitted that the main case is now listed for 31.10.2023 and he wishes to withdraw the same and thus, prays for allowing of the application and for the preponement of the main case from 31.10.2023 to today itself.
3. On the other hand, learned State Counsel has submitted that she has no objection in case the present application is allowed and the date of hearing in the main case is preponed from 31.10.2023 to today itself for

final disposal.

4. For the reasons stated in the application and in view of no objection from the opposite side, the present application is allowed and the date of hearing in the main case is preponed from 31.10.2023 to today and the same is taken on Board today itself for final disposal.

Main case

1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 02.09.2020 (Annexure P-2) vide which, the Superintendent of Police, Rohtak initiated the departmental inquiry against the petitioner and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that since, the petitioner has been discharged in the FIR case thus, he seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present Civil Writ Petition.
