The petitioner is seeking the concession of bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 in case FIR No.13 dated 28.02.2021 under Sections 302, 307, 378-B(2), 323 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Ghuman, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the petitioner has now been in custody since 28.02.2021 and there is no possibility of the trial concluding in the near future as the prosecution evidence has not yet concluded.

Per contra, learned State counsel on instructions has controverted the submissions made by the counsel opposite by submitting that in fact the prosecution evidence has concluded and the trial thus is not going to take much time to conclude.

In view of the submissions made by the learned State

counsel, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner does not press the instant petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.
