The prayer in the petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuances of directions to respondent no.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent nos.4 & 5 as the petitioner is being threatened to compromise the matter with respondent no.6 in FIR No.55 dated 24.03.2023 under Section 323, 341, 324, 34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) registered at P.S. Mataur, District SAS Nagar.

The Counsel for the petitioner has referred to the transcript of the telephonic conversation purportedly between the petitioner and respondent no.5-reader to the respondent no.4 to contend that he is being threatened with cancellation of the FIR and action to be taken against him (petitioner).

The Counsel for the State on the other hand contends that an

application had been moved by the accused for further investigation which is still pending. In the said application, the petitioner being the complainant of the FIR had been called for investigation but has refused to join the same.

Be that as it may, it would be appropriate if the SSP, Mohali personally looks into the matter and files an appropriate report before the Illaqa Magistrate concerned within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
