order or direction especially in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the impugned notice dated 24.05.2016 (Annexure P-10) and impugned inquiry report dated 28.03.2016 (Annexure P-9).

Learned State counsel has pointed out that in the present case, the impugned show cause notice has been issued to the petitioners to show as to why they should not be placed under suspension and has submitted that during the pendency of the present writ petition, the term of the petitioners as Sarpanch/Panch has expired in the year 2018, thus, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, in view of the above-said statement of learned State counsel, has submitted that the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may be disposed of as such.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.
