1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 6 to proceed further with the representation/complaint dated 31.03.2022 (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioner for taking an appropriate legal action against private respondent No.7 who in connivance with unidentified persons armed with weapons, forcibly and mercilessly beating the petitioner and his wife, snatched money from them and thrown them out from the Gurudwara Shaheed Baba Santokh Singh, Village Varpal, Tehsil Amritsar-2, District Amritsar.

2. Status report dated 02.11.2022 by way of an affidavit of Sh.Parvesh Chopra, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Attari, Amrtisar (Rural) has already been filed by the State. As per the

said status report, the inquiry has been conducted in the complaint dated 31.03.2022 (Annexure P-4) made by the petitioner and from the oral and circumstantial evidence, it is found that Major Singh, brother of the petitioner and Jagjit Singh, son of the petitioner, had executed a sale deeds on 09.01.2020 and 16.01.2020 in the favour of Misal Baba Deep Singh Shaheeda Gurdwara Samadh Baba Naudh Singh Shaheed Loh Mata Langar Tarna Dal Head Baba Gajjan Singh Chevin Patshahi, Baba Bakala Sahib. The allegations made by the petitioner with respect of the looting of his belongings, beating, snatching the car and the money taken by ASI Samunder Singh did not prove and no truth was found in the contents of the complaint dated 31.03.2022 (Annexure P-4) and it was recommended to consign the same to the record room.

3. In view of above status report filed by the State, no further directions are required to be given in the present petition and the same is disposed of accordingly.
