1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the order dated 09.06.2016 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.1.
2. Learned counsel for respondent No.1-UT Chandigarh has submitted that the impugned order is appealable.
3. Although, the case has been called twice but no one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioners in order to rebut the abovesaid aspect.
