1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent No.3 to correct his date of birth in the passport.

2. The petitioner was issued passport in the year 1982 wherein his date of birth was mentioned as 13.04.1962. The petitioner claims that his date of birth is 08.02.1965 and correct date of birth be recorded in the passport.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that petitioner had served in Indian Army and as per his service record as well as other documents, the actual date of birth is 08.02.1965 and in the passport it got wrongly recorded as 13.04.1962.

4. Mr. Sharma, learned counsel for the respondent Nos.1 and 3 while pointing out reply submits that petitioner may be directed to

submit all the documents in support of his contention and competent authority would pass an appropriate order.

5. Without commenting upon merits of the case, the present petition stands disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to appear in the office of respondent No.3 on 17.08.2023 at 11:00 AM along with record available with him. On doing so, the respondent shall pass an appropriate order within four weeks thereafter.
