NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

This criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India for directions to the official respondent Nos.2 and 3 not to harass the petitioners illegally at the behest of respondent Nos.4 to 6 and also directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 to restrain respondent Nos.4 to 6 from interfering in the married life of the petitioners.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that let this petition be disposed of only with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Patiala (respondent No.2) to consider and decide the representation dated 02.06.2023 (Annexure P-4) alleged to have been submitted by the petitioners seeking protection for their lives and personal liberty.

Accordingly, and without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioners and even the assertions set out in the petition, the same is disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.2 that if any such representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, it shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law.
