The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.156 dated 07.10.2022 registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, Police Station Lalru, District SAS Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not pressing for regular bail and prays to grant interim bail to the petitioner as his brother-Jasveer Singh is suffering from Cancer and attached his Discharge and follow-up Card, Government Medical College Hospital, Sector 32, Chandigarh. Jeet Singh-father of the petitioner, is also 85% disabled. Thus, he prays for one month interim bail to the petitioner to look after them.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and have also gone through the documents on record.

Keeping in view the above, the petition is disposed of and the petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail for a period of one month, on execution of the bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petitioner shall surrender before the jail authorities forthwith on expiry of the interim bail period.
