This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 12.06.2019 (Annexure P-2).

Learned State Counsel has pointed out that challenge in the present writ petition is to the order dated 12.06.2019 which had been passed under Section 408A(2) of the Haryana Municipal Corporation Act, 1994 and the said order is appealable under Section 408B of the Act, whereas in paragraph 11 of the present writ petition, it has been mentioned that there is no remedy of appeal or revision and has thus, submitted that the present writ petition deserves to be dismissed with costs.
