The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners, in case FIR No.122 dated 23.06.2022 registered under Sections 306/34 IPC at Police Station Division No.7, Jalandhar.

Vide order dated 21.07.2022, petitioners were granted the concession of anticipatory bail in the following terms:-

“The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in the present case the allegations were pertaining to Section 306 IPC and as per the allegations there was suicide note as well in which the only allegation was with regard to harassment faced by the deceased from the friends and, therefore, on the face of it the essential ingredients which are sine-quo-non under Sections 107 and 306 IPC are not fulfilled and even otherwise also the dispute, if any was pertaining to some non-payment of loan and, therefore, the provision of Section 306 IPC cannot be attracted.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to order dated 21.07.2022, passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation. This fact is not disputed by the counsel for the State as well.

Learned State counsel on instructions states that the petitioners are no longer required for further interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 21.07.2022, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
