Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for quashing of judgment of conviction dated 22.03.2017 & order of sentence dated 23.03.2017 passed by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kurukshetra in FIR No.139 dated 13.04.2012 under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC as well as FIR No. 139 dated 13.04.2012, charge-sheet dated 06.01.2015 along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (P-5), entered into between the parties i.e. petitioner as well as respondent No.2.
