The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.147 dated 18.06.2022 registered under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Civil Lines, Bathinda.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in compliance with order dated 22.07.2022 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 22.07.2022 whereby the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
