AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

1. This petition was filed seeking quashing of FIR No. 6 dated 8.1.2018, under Sections 406, 420 IPC and Section 24 of the Emigration Act, 1983 registered at Police Station Garhshankar, District Hoshiarpur.
2. On 21.7.2022, the petitioners and respondent No. 2 were directed to get their statements recorded.
3. On 2.9.2022, learned counsel for respondent No. 2 sought more time for petitioners and private respondent for recording of their statements.
4. Vide order dated 7.12.2022, in the absence of counsel for the petitioners and respondent No. 2, another opportunity was granted to them for recording of the statements.
5. None appeared for the petitioners and respondent No. 2 on 1.3.2023. Similar is the position today.
6. Prima facie, it appears that there is no compromise between the parties.
7. The petition is dismissed.
