1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners as they apprehend threat to their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.3 & 4 and to direct them not harass and interfere in the life of the petitioners.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are in a live in relationship with their own consent. It is contended that petitioners are major, as their ages being 20 years and 21 years, respectively. The copies of 'Aadhaar' card of petitioners (Annexures P-1 and P-2) have been placed on record. They alleged that there is a threat to their life and liberty from respondents No.3 & 4, and in this regard they have submitted representation dated 05.06.2023 (Annexure P-3) to respondent No.2 i.e. the Superintendent of Police, Rural, for redressal of their grievance but no action has been taken thereon.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Pardeep Parkash Chahar, Sr. DAG, Haryana, appears and accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

5. Without commenting upon the validity of the said relation between the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider the representation dated 05.06.2023 (Annexure P-3) and take requisite action, if so warranted, as per the facts and circumstances of the matter, in accordance with law.
