HARKESH MANUJA J.

1. By way of present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, prayer has been made for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners as the police officials are harassing and humiliating them at the instance of private respondents.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already approached respondents No.2 and 3 through representation dated 20.05.2023 (Annexure P-3), but no action has been taken so far in the matter. He further submits that he would be satisfied, if direction is issued to official respondents to decide representation (Annexure P-3) moved by the petitioners, in a time-bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the paper book has been supplied to learned

counsel for the respondents-State

5. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and after perusing the paper-book, but without commenting on merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with a request to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, District Ferozepur to look into the grievances of the petitioners unfolded in the representation dated 20.05.2023 (Annexure P-3) and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from today. However, it is made clear that the aforesaid order shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the contents stated in the said representation.

6. Disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
