Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are already working as Sister Tutor in the various Government Hospitals and intend to get absorbed in the Department of Medical Education and Research where the posts of sister tutor are lying vacant.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioners are working in the Department of Health whereas, they are claiming their transfer to the Department of Medical Education and Research, which is totally a separate Department, hence, the claim of the petitioners is not sustainable as they are only entitled to continue in the Department of Health.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record with their able assistance.

Once the petitioners were appointed in the Department of Health and are already working as Sister Tutors in various hospitals which come under the Department of Health, Government of Haryana, their that they should be

transferred to the post of Sister Tutor in the Department of Medical Education and Research is not permissible. No Rule has been brought to the notice of this Court which permit that the post of Sister Tutor in the Health Department is inter-transferable with that of Sister Tutor in the Department of Medical Education and Research. In the absence of any rule allowing inter-transfer between the Department of Health and Department of Medical Education and Research, the plea of the petitioners that they should be considered for posting as Sister Tutor in the Hospital which come under the Department of Medical Education and Research, cannot be allowed.

Keeping in view the above, no ground is made out for the grant of relief as being prayed by the petitioners in the present petition.

Dismissed.
