[1] Prayer in the third petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.57 dated 26.04.2021 under Sections 22, 29 of NDPS Act, 1985 and later on added Section 61, 85 of NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Shambhu, District Patiala.
