1. In the present writ petition, the prayer of the petitioner is for revising the final result so as to declare the petitioner as a successful candidate in the reserved category of Scheduled Caste for the post of Clerk.

2. Learned State counsel submits that in the revised result, the petitioner has already been found eligible and his name has already been recommended, which is clear from the recommendation letter dated 17.10.2023, hence, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may kindly be disposed of as such.

3. No one appears on behalf of the petitioner to rebut the said contention.

4. Keeping in view the above, as the name of the petitioner has already been recommended, no further orders are required to be passed in

the present writ petition.

5. Petitioner is given liberty that in case any of his grievance still survives, he can approach the respondents by filing appropriate representation.

6. The present writ petition is disposed of in above terms.
