GURBIR SINGH, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners seek a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondents Nos.2 and 3, to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No. 4 to 9 and not to allow anybody else to interfere with the liberty and life of the petitioners or to harass in any manner or to cause any detriment to the petitioners in any manner.

It is stated that respondents No. 4 to 9 used to harass and humiliate the petitioners. They are threatening to kill the petitioners and due to the fear/danger to their life and further threatening to implicate in false cases, the petitioners are living under constant threat.

The petitioners have approached the respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana by way of complaint dated 23.01.2023 (Annexure P-2), but no action has been taken thereon. He submits that petitioners would be satisfied if their complaint dated 23.01.2023 is decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 to 3.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Himani Arora, AAG, Punjab

accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and on a perusal of the paper book, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No./competent authority to look into the complaint dated 23.01.2023 (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioners and if necessary to take appropriate action on the same, as per law as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of one month.
