The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.102 dated 16.05.2023 registered under Sections 149, 382, 440, 447, 506 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Sector 6, Dharuhera, District Rewari.

Mr. Tarun Yadav, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of complainant and has filed his Vakalatnama. The same is taken on record.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 12.06.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Manoj Kumar admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 12.06.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
