Main case

Seeking release of the detenue-Anjali who is under detention of respondent No.4 and further direction to official respondent No.4 to produce the detenue before the Court and allow her to go with the petitioner or with whom the detenue will show her desire to go, the petitioner has come up before this Court.

2. Counsel appearing for the state question the locus of the petitioner to file the present petition as she is not in relation to the detenue in any manner.
3. At this stage, petitioner's counsel submits that they might have some documents which he would annex in the next petition, therefore, he prayed for the disposal of the present petition with liberty to file a fresh.
4. Given above, the present petition is disposed of being devoid of locus at this stage. Liberty reserved to file a fresh petition in case the petitioner has any locus or authority to do the same. However considering the serious nature of allegations, State is directed to ensure safety and protection of the detenue-Anjali. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
