The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus seeking direction to respondents to release the pensionary benefits of the petitioner i.e. pension, gratuity, leave encashment, provident fund, commutation of pension etc. along with interest.

The interest was claimed on account of the fact that the petitioner was retired from services on 30.04.2018 and none of the aforesaid legal dues of the petitioner were released to him without any justifiable reason by the respondent-Municipal Corporation, Faridabad.

Notice of motion was issued in the matter on 01.07.2019 and thereafter, though the Municipal Corporation, Faridabad choose not to file any written

statement but controverting the aforesaid facts submits that all the aforesaid dues as claimed by the petitioner in the instant petition have been released along with interest on account of delay at the rate of 6% per annum.

Mr. Viren Nehra, Advocate appearing for Mr. Sunil K. Nehra, Advocate does not controvert the aforesaid assertion made by learned counsel for respondent No.3.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of as having become infructuous, as the relief sought for in the prayer clause of the instant petition stands addressed.
