Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to verify experience and sports certificates as well as other educational and co-curricular certificates of private respondents. Another prayer has also been made for quashing the selection and appointment of private respondents to the post of Female Supervisor.

At the outset, counsel for the petitioner submits that there are some disputed factual aspects, which cannot be adjudicated in the writ petition. He seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to approach the Civil Court, if so advised.
