The present petition has been filed for quashing the transfer order dated 31.05.2023 (Annexure P-3). Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is disabled and he has been transferred twice within period of 50 days which is contrary to the policy laid down by the State Government for transfer.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was recently transferred from Nawashehar to Hoshiarpur on 12.04.2023 and within 50 days he has been transferred from Hoshiarpur to Nawashahar again.

This court finds that transfers are incidents of service and unless there is an allegation of malafide which have been proved, no interference ordinarily required to be made in decsioin relating to transfer of the employees. This Court also finds that the petitioner has been contineously working at Hoshiarpour for a long time and has actually been transferred after 2021 for a short period off side of Hoshiparpur. Even other wise the

place where the petitioner has been transferred is not much far from Hoshiprapur.

In view of the position explained above, no interference is warranted by this Court to the transfer order and accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
