SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

1. Though the petitioners received an adverse verdict from the learned Collector concerned (Annexure P-2), inasmuch as, thereby the eviction petition of the Gram Panchayat Amlala, Block Dera Bassi, District SAS Nagar through Baljit Singh Panch, thus became decreed. However, the aggrieved-respondents judgment-debtors instituted an appeal thereagainst, before the learned Commissioner concerned, which is stated at the bar, by the learned counsel for the petitioners today, to be still subjudice.

2. The grievance which led the present petitioners to institute the instant writ petition before this Court became comprised in the factum, that despite an application for staying the operation of Annexure P-2 becoming instituted before the learned Appellate Authority, yet no decision being made thereon. Resultantly, it is espoused before this Court by the aggrieved-petitioners, that thereby the very purpose of filing an appeal (Annexure P-3) has been rendered infructuous.

3. However, today it is stated, at the bar by the learned State counsel, that the learned Appellate Authority concerned, has on the relevant interim application thus ordered the parties to maintain *status-quo* in respect of the petition lands.

4. Therefore, in view of the above, since the relief (*supra*), which earlier did not come to be granted to the petitioners rather has now been granted by the learned Appellate Authority concerned, to the present petitioners, thereby the instant writ petition becomes rendered infructuous.

5. Dismissed as becoming rendered infructuous.
