1. This is the second petition filed by the petitioner for grant of regular bail in a case having FIR No.636 dated 28.10.2022 registered under Sections 308, 323, 324, 506 IPC at Police Station Ladwa, District Kurukshetra.
2. The counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is incarcerated for the last more than 8 months and now dispute between the parties has been amicably settled and in the quashing petition filed by the petitioner, the statements have already been recorded before the

trial Court, wherein the complainant and other injured/eye-witnesses have admitted the factum of compromise and the copies of the said statements have been filed and the same are ordered to be taken on record.

- 3. Status report along with MLR (Annexure R-1) and copy of opinion of doctors (Annexure R-2) filed by the State counsel are ordered to be taken on record. State counsel on instructions from SI Mul Chand has not disputed the factum of compromise which has been effected between the parties.
- 4. Even the counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant has not refuted the fact that the dispute between the parties has been resolved amicably.
- 5. As per the custody certificate furnished by the State counsel, the petitioner is in custody for the last more than 8 months. It is also apparent that matter has been compromised.
- 6. In view of the above, no fruitful purpose is going to be served by prolonging judicial custody of the petitioner for indefinite period. Thus, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.
