Status report by way of affidavit of Shri Tarlochan Singh,
Deputy Superintendent of Police, Rupnagar, District Rupnagar, alongwith
custody certificate has been filed.

Initially 01 pistol and 07 cartridges were recovered from the
possession of the petitioner. On the basis of disclosure statement, he got
recovered a concealed bag containing 8 pistols and 13 live cartridges.

Contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that the
case is triable by the Magistrate.

Considering the heavy recovery of arms and ammunition
from the possession of the petitioner, this is not a fit case for grant of
regular bail.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner has made
prayer to direct the Trial Court to expedite the trial.

Present petition is dismissed. However, a direction is given to
the Trial Court to make every possible efforts to expedite the trial.
