Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.35 dated 30.01.2023 registered under Sections 336/34 of the IPC and Section 27 of Arms Act registered at Police Station Sohana, District SAS Nagar, Punjab.

On instructions from ASI Balbir Singh, it is conceded by learned State counsel that weapon has already been recovered from the petitioner and though he has not got recovered the empty cartridges but regarding the same Section 201 of the IPC has been added.

Learned State counsel submits that petitioner is no longer required for further investigation.

In view of the same and having regard to the factual position noticed earlier on 09.06.2023, the petition is allowed and the order dated 09.06.2023 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
