Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of habeas corpus in the matter of preventive detention; where learned Children Court did not adopt rehabilitation Card/Form No.14 procedure of Juvenile Justice Model Rule 2016, Annexure P-5, alongwith writ of certiorari to quash the juvenile transfer order, Annexures P-3 and P-4 to release the detenue from unlawful/wrongful custody of petitioner's son from the Central Jail, Amritsar.

After arguing at length, counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of this petition with liberty to the petitioner to raise her pleas at the time of arguments in CRR-2850-2022, which is already pending consideration before this Court.

Allowed as prayed for.

Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
