The prayer under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.77 dated 20.05.2023 under Sections 420 IPC and Sections 103 & 104 of Trade Marks Act, 1999 registered at Police Station Division No.2, Police Commissionerate Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 09.06.2023 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel has filed status report by way of affidavit of Mr. Ashok Kumar, Assistant Commissioner of Police PBI/NDP S-Cum-Narcotics Ludhiana, Additional Charge as ACP (Central), Ludhiana, which is taken on record and on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 09.06.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 09.06.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
